

## **HRH THE PRINCE OF WALES VISITED THE RAHMI M. KOÇ MUSEUM**

HRH the Prince of Wales has been greeted by Rahmi M. Koç, Honorary Chairman of the Koç Holding

Their Royal Highnesses Prince of Wales and Duchess of Cornwall arrived in Turkey on Saturday and on their visit to the Rahmi M. Koç Museum viewed the following objects in detail.



A railway carriage made in England and used by Sultan Abdul Aziz to tour Europe by train in 1867. The Sultan met many European heads of state during the journey, including Queen Victoria, the direct ancestor of His Royal Highness. The carriage was restored in the workshops of the Rahmi M. Koç Museum.

Another object he viewed was a unique large-scale model of a removal van used to transport the furniture of the Duke and Duchess of York (grandparents of His Royal Highness) from White Lodge, Richmond to 145 Piccadilly, London in 1927.

In addition to the above, HRH passed through the Rail Transport, Living History, and Outdoor Maritime departments of the Museum on the way to the Museum's Conference Room, where His Royal Highness gave a speech to an invited audience.
